Amman East IPP 1 Power Project is a 375MW dual-fuel fired power project. It is located in Amman, Jordan. According to GlobalData, who tracks and profiles over 170,000 power plants worldwide, the project is currently active. It has been developed in a single phase. Post completion of construction, the project got commissioned in August 2009.

Who owns Amman east IPP?

All the electricity produced and the capacity made available by Amman East IPP is purchased by National Electric Power Company (NEPCO) under a long term Power Purchase Agreement ("PPA") until 2034. Amman East IPP is the first independent power producer ("IPP") in Jordan. Amman East owns and operates a 381 MW gas fired power generating facility.
