Can a power bank fly in China?

A: In China, power banks must be under 100Wh and 3C Certified. This rule applies to all domestic and international flights. If your power bank goes over the limit or lacks the 3C mark, it can't fly. Security officers at the airport will check this during screening. You'll need to carry it in your hand luggage, not checked baggage.
