Is Mozambique lagging behind in the development of telecommunications?

Compared to the United States, Mozambique is massively lagging behind in the development of telecommunications. Under the country code +258, there were a total of 15.03 million connections in 2023. Among them were 15.00 million mobile phones, which corresponds to an average of 0.46 per person. In the US, this figure is 1.2 mobile phones per person.

What type of radio stations dominate in Mozambique?

Community radio stations comprise 64.1% of existing stations in Mozambique, showing how important they are to the broadcasting of information and music. Some 118 radio stations exist in Mozambique, mainly public and community radio stations.
